# 2022 AMYA DF95 Region 4 Championship

**June 17-19, 2022**

This regatta will be hosted by Michigan RC Sailing Club (MRCSC) and sailed at Cabela's pond in Dundee, Michigan. Cabela's address is: 110 Cabela Blvd E, Dundee, MI 48131.

**Governance:** This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, as amended by Appendix E for RC sailing, prescriptions of US Sailing, The Class Rules of the DF95, the Sailing Instructions, and by any changes announced by the Principle Race Officer (PRO) during the course of the event.

**Eligibility:** All competitors must be a current member of the AMYA or (Canada) Skipper's national authority. While this may or may not be checked during registration, please be sure to have your membership card with you or, at minimum, the ability to access your member credentials on your country organization website via your mobile device or computer.

**How to Register:** Registration is completed via the AMYA.org website under the event "2022 Region 4 DF95 Championship."

Racing continues until approximately 5pm and may continue beyond 5pm at the PRO's discretion.

**Sunday (June 19)**

9:30am Skippers Meeting

10am Racing begins

12pm Lunch served

Racing continues until approximately 3:00pm and may continue slightly beyond 3pm at the PRO's discretion.

Awards **as soon as possible** after the last race is completed.

**Mandatory DF95 Class Boat Inspections:**

- All competitors shall ensure that their DF95 RC Racing Yacht is inspected by a technical officer prior to racing in the regatta.
- No boat is eligible to race until it has been registered and has passed equipment inspection.
- At the discretion of the PRO, spot checks may be conducted of any competitors boat in order to ensure that they “continue to comply” with DF95 class rules at all times during the regatta.

**Race/Heat Management:** Heats and races will be by HMS (promotion/relegation) if more than 20 entries are received.

**Late Entry Fee:** AMYA.org event registration will no longer accept payment after June 1. All entries after June 1, 2022 are considered late entries. **Late entry fees will increase to \$55.** Cash is acceptable for late entries on-site at the regatta site (June 17<sup>th</sup> practice day or early AM June 18<sup>th</sup> during the registration period). Checks ARE NOT ACCEPTED.
