DMYC will have sailing yachts representing the six sanctioned racing classes sponsored by the club at the pond. The six classes are DragonForce 65 (DF-65), DragonFlite 95 (DF-95), Soling One Meter, East Coast 12 Meter (EC-12), Marblehead, and International 10 Rater.

In addition to fleet racing, attendees may also see a little match racing with a couple 1.7 Meter racing yachts.

The boat show is shaping up to have a nice collection of old-time sailing yachts built over the years by various members of the DMYC. Attendees of the event will have an opportunity to lay eyes on yachts as old as a 1940's Vintage Marblehead. Yachts at the show will range in size from the smallest being a Footy to the largest and majestic 1/16 scale J-Class modeled after the 1930's era America's Cup racing yachts and several others in-between. Some of the classics may even get rigged and sailed in the regatta.
